The boundary map

Seaham town centre is centred on the historic shopping area of Church Street and the adjoining Byron Place Shopping Centre on South Terrace. The town centre extends northwards towards the top of North Terrace, incorporating the commercial units and public space located at the edge of North Railway Street.

At its lower edge, the town centre boundary sweeps from Byron Place around the rear of Church Street, continuing through Shelley Street and Viceroy Street, before returning via Sophia Street to Blanford Place, and finally continuing down the rear of Church Street towards Green Street.

It also includes some of the areas linked to the town centre and which will have an influence on the Vision for the town including Seaham Train Station, Seaham Harbour Marina, Nose's Point (Durham Heritage Coast), the Conservation Area and Tommy World War One Soldier Sculpture - Eleven 'O' One.

We want to know if you think we have missed any important areas which should be included in the map.
